WINTER NO-PARKING CONDITION ALERT

SUBJECT: Winter No-Parking Condition Alert Issued by the City of Decatur.

The City of Decatur is issuing an alert giving all drivers advance notice that predicted weather conditions could necessitate the declaration of a winter no-parking condition in the near future.

At the present time, however, all normal traffic and parking regulations remain in effect.

If a winter no-parking condition is declared, the following restrictions would go into effect on streets posted with Winter No-Parking streets:

1. The parking, leaving or standing of any vehicle would be banned on designated Winter No-Parking streets. Winter No-Parking streets are identified by red and white signs.
2. Any vehicle parked on these streets would have to be removed by the time specified in declaration of the winter no-parking condition.

DECLARATION OF WINTER NO-PARKING CONDITION

CODE #2

SUBJECT: Winter No-Parking Condition is Declared by the City of Decatur.

The City of Decatur has declared a winter no-parking condition effective at:

5:00 AM/PM on 2/1/22

Emergency provisions of Section 11 of Chapter 34 of the City Code of the City of Decatur, Illinois, establishing Winter No-Parking Condition will become effective at that time.

Under the winter no-parking regulations:

The parking, leaving or standing of any vehicle is prohibited on designated Winter No-Parking streets. The winter no-parking streets are identified by red and white signs. The sign reads: **"Winter No-Parking, When Snow or Ice is on Street, Tow Away Zone"**.

All vehicles now parked on the winter no-parking streets must be removed within six (6) hours of the designated time of this declaration, regardless of normal parking regulations on these streets. Violators of winter no-parking regulations are subject to fines and towing.
